

PROCEDURES FOR INDIVIDUAL COMPETITORS

- Check-in and hand music copies and AMCOS agreements (if not already sent) to Eisteddfod Desk located in centre foyer 45 mins prior to commencement of session.
- If you are competing in Modern Ballad and using recorded music please make sure you have it uploaded by the end of July. Modern Ballad to have no vocal on backing tracks.
- Dance ensure your CD's are in the correct MP3 Format and lodged at the Music Desk at least 1 hour prior to your performance.
- Move backstage when called by Auditorium Compere, and wait in the hallway.
- A Marshal will assist with ensuring that you are accounted for and bought onto the wings to await your performance
- If you are awarded a place please proceed quickly to the stage for your bow.
 - Certificates will be available for collection from the Eisteddfod office.

PLEASE NOTE: If you choose to predict competitor times please err on the side of caution, remembering factors such as illness and withdrawals which will affect item running times.

Unfortunately we cannot hold items for late participants.

❖ If you are competing in two Sections ie Vocal and Speech, would you please advise on your entry form. This is to assist us when we compile the programme.
